TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE BAKERY SUMMER COURSE

🖌 GENERAL CLAUSE

Enrolment in the Bakery Summer Course implies that the client accepts the present Terms and conditions without exception, and commits to respect the Internal Rules of the Institute INBP, available upon request.

- APPLICATION

The client must complete the application form and sign the agreement accepting the terms and conditions of the Bakery Summer Course, and return it together with a copy of valid passport or Identity Card for UE residents, **before June 1**st, **2021** -> **By email to : international@inbp.com**

CONDITIONS

The Bakery Summer Course is open to all English-speaking adults (+18) from motivated amateurs to professionals.

All participants have to bring appropriate clothing and shoes. (contact us for details).

- *Option 1* The client signs for the **one week Bakery Summer Course** (from **July 5th** to **July 9th, 2021**): by signing the application form, the client commits himself/ herself to taking part in the one-week Bakery Summer Course he/she registered to, if it is maintained.
- *Option 2* The client signs for the **two-weeks Bakery Summer Course** (from **July 5th** to **July 16th, 2021**): by signing the application form, the client commits himself/ herself to taking part in the Bakery Summer Course if it is maintained, even if one week of the Bakery Summer Course is cancelled.

The maximum number of participants is 14 per week. The minimum number of participants required for the Bakery Summer Course to take place is 10 per week: The INBP will inform the client on June 4th, 2021 by email if the Bakery Summer Course is maintained and if so which option of the Bakery Summer Course 1 or 2 is maintained.

Payment of the maintained selected option has to be made directly upon the receipt of the email from the INBP confirming which option of the Bakery Summer Course is maintained (**June 4th, 2021**).

Payment must be made in Euros only (all bank fees are carried by the client), by international bank transfer (please indicate your family name and purpose: Bakery Summer Course - 1 week or 2 weeks). The client has to notify the INBP of the payment by sending a proof of the bank transfer as soon as made.

Participation of the client to the selected option of the Bakery Summer Course will only be confirmed if full payment of the selected option of the Summer Course is on the INBP bank account **before June 15th, 2021**. As there are a limited number of places (14 per week), applications will be dealt with on a first pay first serve basis.

If the client does not fulfil the above conditions, the INBP reserves the right to refuse his/her admittance.

CLIENT CANCELLATION

If the Bakery Summer Course is maintained and the client cancels, for any reason (except in case of duly established "Force majeure*"),

following cancellation fees apply: - From June 4th, 2021 to June 14th, 2021: 30% of the total amount of the course.

- After **June 15th**, **2021**: 100% of the total amount of the course.

✓ INBP CANCELLATION

In the event of "Force majeure", or of the INBP absolute impossibility to lead the Bakery Summer Course, or of a late cancellation of a participant leading to an insufficient number of participants or a cancellation in compliance with the French government measures and regulations, the INBP reserves the right to cancel the Bakery Summer Course prior to the course beginning.

The client will be notified by email if his/her selected option the Bakery Summer Course is cancelled, and the INBP will reimburse the full amount paid by the client on the INBP bank account less bank fees (fixed amount of $50 \in$).
